

Town of Cinco Bayou Council Meeting
January 3, 1967

Present Mayor Ronald Gibson, Attorney Estergren, Councilmen Edward Laritz, Paul Hutchison, Peter Sonnenberg, Lowell Taylor. Meeting began at 7:30 p.m. Several visitors were also present.

The monthly finance report was read. Mayor Gibson reposted

Mayor Gibson reported the traffic left turn signal light was to be installed at the corner of Yacht Club and Eglin Parkway. Councilman Laritz moved we turn all work over to Joe Wilkins to repair traffic light at \$7 per repair. Councilman Taylor seconded the motion. Motion approval.

Mayor Gibson contacted commissioner, William Landreth concerning Bridge and Road Funds. We had not received any revenues since 1960.

Councilman Laritz moved we make application for city water. Seconded by Councilman Hutchison. Motion approval.

A public hearing was held to consider protest concerning rezoning Lots 2, 3, 4, 14, 15, 16, and 17, Block 10 from R1 Multiple Family dwelling district to C2 general commercial district. Councilman Laritz moved all persons owning property write to the town of Cinco Bayou stating what lots would be used for and when they would be developed. Councilman Taylor seconded the motion. Motion Approval.

Councilman Taylor moved we buy dry asphalt to repair all streets and repair and replace street signs, seconded by Councilman Laritz. Motion carried.

Following a discussion of the need of a post office in the town of Cinco Bayou a motion was made by Councilman Laritz we make bid for a post office in our town. The motion was seconded by Councilman Hutchison. Motion approved.
