

Town of Cinco Bayou Council Meeting
January 5, 1966

Present Attorney Fred Estergren, Mayor Gordon Gibson, Councilmen Ed Laritz, Ronald Gibson, Paul Hutchison, and G. A. Balsley. Several visitors were present.

Minutes of previous meeting were read and approved.

Mr. Estergren read a letter from State Road Dept, Tallahassee, Fla., about light at Eglin Parkway and Yacht Club Drive. They ask for five carbon copies, all signed in regards to traffic light. Council asked to find out cost, plan engineer, traffic, the state would pay 40% of cost. Motion made by Ronald Gibson, seconded by Ed Laritz to go ahead with the loan at Frist National Bank to begin building town hall on Kelly Street end of Andalusia Street. Okaloosa Gas Company would loan \$4000 at 4% interest payable over a period of five years by utility taxes.

Water franchise, Cinco Council meet with FWB Council, December 30, 1965 to discuss the issue and learn FWB's demands. Mayor Gibson and Councilmen R. Gibson meet with county commissioner, Bill Landreth and Engineer, Mr. Lee discussed the possibility of Cinco getting water from the county system, a verbal commitment exchanged at 5,000 gallons \$3.50 minimum a month, no tap in fee for those now on water sewer all others would be \$100 tap in \$7.50 meter deposit, send our present existing lines to county, (30 years franchise) may before water would be furnished possibly 1967 before sewer service could be offered (May 1, 1966 interaur period water). Council sugessted to wait until we get FWB's proposal, there extend to their the same opportunity to furnish or match the offer. The county makes Okaloosa County's plan meets the pøople's approval.

Appoint Mayor Pro Tem, nominees: Ronald Gibson and Ed Laritz- vote
Ed Laritz nominated proposal by Balsley to have all meetings on first
Monday night in each month, motioned made by Laritz, seconded by Paul
Hutchison. Motion carried.

Mr. Ray Kelly will get a proposal to present on the water situation.

Motion to adjourn by Laritz, seconded Hutchison, approved by all.
