

Town of Cinco Bayou Council Meeting  
January 6, 1970

The Cinco Bayou Town Council met at 7:30 p.m., with the following members present: Mayor Lowell Taylor, Council members Irene Balsley, Iza Booher, Paul Hutchison, Edward Laritz, and Harold Peek, and Attorney Estergren.

Mayor Taylor called the meeting to order and the minutes of the December meeting were read. Councilman Laritz moved the acceptance of the minutes with the inclusion of Mayor Taylor's name in the listing of the 1970 officers sworn in. Motion was seconded and carried unanimously.

Mayor Taylor recommended the following: (1) A Mayor Pro-Tem be elected. Councilman Peek made a motion that Councilman Laritz be Mayor Pro-Tem. Motion seconded by Councilman Hutchison motion carried. (2) The pictures of previous Mayors at Howard Studio's for \$45.66 be paid for and picked up. Statement was made this had been approved. (3) We purchased coal mix. Councilman Laritz made the motion that one yard of coal mix be bought. The motion was seconded by Councilman Booher. Motion carried unanimously. (4) Launch slabs be repaired.

Attorney Estergren stated that Moore Handley and Okaloosa Gas District have not come to an agreement on the high pressure gas line under Moore Handley's Showroom.

A motion was made by Councilman Laritz that we send our annual membership of \$55.00 to the Florida League of Municipalities. Councilman Peek seconded the motion. Carried unanimously.

Mr. Freeman of Moore Handley wants a traffic light at Hughes Street and Eglin Parkway, stated Councilman Laritz.

A motion was made by Councilman Booher to get bids from different insurance companies on the Town Hall. Councilman Balsley seconded the motion and volunteered to get bids from State Farm and Allstate Insurance Companies. Town Clerk was asked to get an appraisal from Government Employee Insurance Company. Motion carried.

The motion to adjourn by Councilman Laritz and seconded by Councilman Booher carried.
