

Town of Cinco Bayou Council Meeting  
January 7, 1969

Cinco Bayou Council Meeting, 7:30 p.m. Present Mayor Gibson, Attorney Estergren, Councilmen Iva Booher, Paul Hutchison, Lowell Taylor, and Peter Sonnenberg.

Minutes of the previous meeting were read. Councilman Sonnenberg moved the minutes be accepted as read, seconded by Councilman Taylor. Motion carried.

Monthly finance report read, Councilman Sonnenberg moved the finance report be accepted as read, seconded by Councilman Booher. Motion carried.

Mayor Gibson reviewed some of unfinished things that had not been completed. He suggested Councilman Sonnenberg get help to get the flag pole extended. Councilman Laritz would finish the city map complete with street numbers.

The Council discussed building requirements in reference to Mr. Butlers garbage. They suggested Attorney Estergren proceed with extending requirements before the Council would take any action. Mayor Gibson suggested the Council review the Southern Standard Building Code book. Possibly this would give them information to compile new building codes for the town. Attorney Estergren suggested they contact a builder to get possible suggestions and main pointers to familiarize members with code requirements. He suggested Jim Kendricks be contacted and ask for assistance. Mayor Gibson appointed Councilman Taylor to head up the review.

Mayor Gibson reported the reason for receiving a lesser amount from the Road Fund for 1968 was largely due to the nontaxable property in our city.

Mayor Gibson read a yearly summary of the Town's 1968 achievements which he had compiled.

Being no further business, Councilman Hutchison moved we adjourn the meeting, seconded by Councilman Sonnenberg. Motion carried.
