I am the owner of Lots 13 and 14, Block 1, Cinco Bayou Sub-Division on Yacht Club Drive. I am planning a 33 unit condominium to be built thereon. I should like a permit to put a "trailer sales office" on the lots, temporarily. SALES OFFICE ON LOTS 13 AND 14, BLOCK 1, CINCO BAYOU
SUBDIVISION

BE IT RESOLVED by the Town Council of Town of Cinco

by the Mayor of Cinco Bayou, Florida.


