

MINUTES OF CINCO BAYOU COUNCIL MEETING

DATE: February 1, 1960, 7:30 P.M.

Meeting called to order at 7:30 P.M. by Mayor Gibson.

Mr. Harmon moved that the Town of Cinco Bayou retain the law firm of Estergren & Rice as its attorneys. Motion seconded by Mr. Disharoon, voting unanimous.

Mr. Estergren made a report on his request to the attorney General for an opinion concerning the town's right to submerged land off Laguna park, reading his letter to the Attorney General and the reply thereto. Mayor Gibson commented that while Mr. Phillips, the adjoining owner, had oral permission to pump sand on his own land, he had no permission to pump sand on the front of the town waterfront in Laguna Park.

Motion by Mr. Disharoon seconded by Mr. Harmon that Mr. Phillips and his attorney, Mr. Ferrin Campbell, be notified that they must remove the fence on his property back to the original PRM, failing which suit for ejectment will be brought by the town, voting unanimous.

Discussion of town's alley from Eglin parkway to Laguna park. Mayor Gibson will discuss situation of obstructions with Mr. Johnson and directed attorneys to research questions connected therewith.

Discussion concerning paving of streets.

Motion by Mr. Harmon, seconded by Mr. Disharoon that town contribute the cost of an ad in the "Playground Visitor" voting unanimous.

All business having been accomplished the meeting adjourned.
