

Town of Cinco Bayou Council Meeting
February 2, 1959 7:00 p.m.

Present: Gordan Gibson, W. J. Gibson, Fred Estegren, Elbert Davis, Paul Hutchison, and Wayne Patton (visitor).

The meeting was called to order by the Mayor and the minutes were read and approved.

Mr. Patton, representing the Playground Chamber of Commerce, asked Cinco Bayou to donate \$3,000 to the cost of the new Chamber of Commerce building. He stated that the building program was short of money and that Ft. Walton was asking for \$3,000 from every area town. Billy Gibson moved that the requested amount be donated and Paul Hutchison seconded the motion. The vote was unanimous. Paul Hutchinson then moved that Cinco Bayou pay \$1,000 now and borrow \$2,000 from the bank for the remainder of the donation. Elbert Davis seconded the motion and the vote was unanimous.

Discussion was held as to whether Cinco should buy a quarter page ad in the new "Playground Visitor" for \$52.50. Mr. Davis moved that the town buy the ad and Mr. Hutchison seconded. The vote was unanimous. The Mayor will word the ad as he sees best.

Billy Gibson moved that a ceiling of \$60 be appropriated for costs in repairing the pumps in the parks. Mr. Hutchison seconded the motion and the vote was unanimous.

A discussion was held favoring a speed-up on fire plugs instead of new street lights at this time.

Mr. Estergren will make an ordinance for raising the utility tax to 10%. Also service stations should be 1200' apart and commercial buildings need 10' leeway from line in rear. This will be put into the form of an ordinance also.

Discussion was held on moving the checking account from the Bank of Ft. Walton to the Southern National Bank.

Mr. Hutchinson moved that the meeting be adjourned and Billy Gibson seconded the motion. Vote was unanimous.
