

Town of Cinco Bayou Council Meeting  
February 3, 1970

The Cinco Bayou Town Council met at 7:30 p.m. with the following members present; Mayor Lowell Taylor; Council members Iva Booher, Paul Hutchison, Edward Laritz, and Harold Peek, and Attorney Estergren.

Mayor Taylor called the meeting to order and the minutes of the January meeting were read. The motion made by Councilman Booher and seconded by Councilman Peek to accept the minutes as read, carried unanimously.

The Financial Report was read and the amount for gas service from Okaloosa County Gas District was questioned. A motion made by Councilman Laritz and seconded by Councilman Hutchison was approved.

Mayor Taylor informed the Council of the following:

1. The launch ramp has been temporarily repaired.
2. Hot patch has been ordered from Okaloosa Asphalt.
3. Miracle Strip sign company has placed 3 street signs in Cinco.
4. The possibility of Cinco Bayou to hook into Okaloosa County Sewer System.
5. A letter has been received from Calude Ft Allison of Charlie Wilkerson Gas and Marine Company requesting that we request our senators and representatives support this bill on taxation of kerosene and fuel oils. The letter was read and Council agreed not to take any action at this time.

Other information brought to the attention of Council:

1. A representative from the Department of Transportation will be in Fort Walton.
2. There is no new information concerning Moore Handley and Okaloosa Gas District.

3. A meeting concerning Proposed Destin Bridge.
4. There is a need for a file system. A motion made by Councilman Laritz and seconded by Councilman Peek to set up a file system carried.
5. Government Employees Insurance Company does not insure commercial buildings.
6. It was recommended that Mr. Davis be asked to remove a tree blocking a sidewalk from a vacant lot.

A motion made by Councilman Laritz and seconded by Councilman Booher to adjourn carried.
