

Town of Cinco Bayou Council Meeting
February 5, 1968

Cinco Bayou Council Meeting, 7:30 p.m. Present Mayor Gibson, Attorney Estergren, Councilmen Lowell Taylor, Iva Booher, Paul Hutchison, and Edward Laritz.

Minutes of the previous meeting were read. Councilman Taylor moved we accept minutes as read, seconded by Councilman Laritz. Motion carried.

Mayor Gibson volunteered to contact Crayle and Co., concerning the final completion of street work on Opp Blvd and Kelly Avenue.

Councilman Taylor reported cost of picnic tables for Laguna Park would be \$507.35 for eight tables.

Councilman Booher moved we make this improvement which will be completed by March 1, seconded by Councilman Hutchison. Motion carried.

Mayor Gibson reported he had discussed with Harold Peek being Civil Defense for the Town of Cinco Bayou which he would accept if it was agreeable with the council members. Councilman Hutchison moved we appoint Harold Peek and pay expense which occur while holding the office of Civil Defense Director for the Town of Cinco Bayou, seconded by Councilman Iva Booher. Motion carried.

C Councilman Laritz moved the City Clerk investigate Workmen's Compensation for our town, seconded by Councilman Taylor. Motion carried.

Mayor Gibson requested we purchase imprinted stationery and envelopes. Councilman Booher moved we accept \$58.26 balance due us from Veteran's Gas Co., and request we hear after get payment monthly. Seconded by Councilman Taylor. Motion carried.

Attorney Estergren read alcohol beverage ordinance. Mayor Gibson

requested Attorney Estergren to check the town charter on restrictions.

Councilman Taylor moved we appoint Councilman Laritz to contact the Ft Walton Beach and Ocean Fire Departments for a Fire Protection contract price for the town, seconded by Councilman Booher. Motion carried.

Councilman Laritz moved we terminate the contract with the Humane Society, seconded by Councilman Taylor. Motion carried.

Councilman Laritz moved we adjourn meeting, seconded by Councilman Booher. Motion carried.
