February 7, 1967

Cinco Bayou Council Meeting, 7:30 p.m. Present Mayor Ronald Gibson, Attorney Estergren, Councilmen Paul Hutchison, Harold Peek, Lowell Taylor. Several visitors were also present.

Councilman Taylor moved we accept the minutes as read after correction was made, seconded by Councilman Peek. Motion carried.

The monthly finance report was read.

Discussion on tap-in fees and hardship cases presented. Nothing definite was done as this will be considered when all Councilman are present.

Mr. Stone representing Gulf Oil Company discussed new storage tanks.

Councilman Taylor moved we amend the resolution that no storage tanks be constructed above the ground. Seconded by Councilman Peek. Carried.

Councilman Taylor moved to make resolution we name new street **Road** ~~Blvd~~ located between Hughes and Opp Blvd, seconded by Councilman Peek. Motion carried.

Mayor Gibson reports traffic turn light to be installed immediately. Attorney Estergren to draft letter to the State Road Department, Chipley, Florida. Attention: Mr. Brannon so he could notify the Gulf Power Co. and the Southeastern Telephone Co., to remove dirt pile near the Sundown Motel.

Mayor Gibson stated a special meeting would be called if necessary after letter was received from owners of lots being rezoned on Troy Street.

Councilman Peek moved we adjourn meeting, seconded by Councilman Taylor. Approved by all.
