

MINUTES OF CINCO BAYOU COUNCIL MEETING

City Attorney, F. B. Estergren, presented petition by Fort Walton Gas Company to allow continuation of their violation of R-2 zoning district.

Motion by L. P. Disharoon and seconded by Elbert Davis that the petition of Fort Walton Gas Company for permission to continue with commercial use of an R-2 zoned lot was considered by council and refused with a suggestion that City Attorney notify the petitioner that the proper remedy of Fort Walton Gas Company was to petition the Board of Adjustment for a variance; it was also noted that the signatories on the petition were not close neighbors of Fort Walton Gas Company.

Discussion concerning water extension and prices for pipe and fire plugs as bid were quoted by two companies.

Discussion concerning right to erect a fire station and council room on the public park area in Cinco Bayou. City attorney requested to give legal opinion.

Motion by councilman Billy Gibson and seconded by Councilman Elbert Davis that the following resolution be adopted:

Whereas the Town of Cinco Bayou, Florida has advertised by posting in three places within the municipality for ten days preceeding this date an advertisement for bids for the proposed water extension system in said town and,

Whereas, the Engineering and Equipment Company of Albany, Georgia, and the American Cast Iron and Pipe Company of Birmingham, Alabama, have made quotations of prices for supplying the needed items, now, therefore, be it resolved that the quotations of the American Cast Iron and Pipe Company be accepted as follows:

2,000 feet	6 inch cast iron Pipe	@ \$1,755.50
4 each of 6"	Mechanical T's	@ 29.18 each
1 each of 6"	Mechanical Joint caps	@ 8.16 "
350'	2 1/4" Cast iron pipe	@ , 723 4 per foot

Be it resolved that the quotations of the Engineering and Equipment Company be accepted as follows:

2	4 1/4" Traffic Model Hydrants	@ \$ 110.50 each
2	Steamer Fire Plugs with one 4" outlet connection and two 2 1/2" NSt. Hose connection	@ 130.00 each
100 ft.	2" Galvanized Pipe	@ 51.44 per foot

and the water committee of the Town of Cinco Bayou, Florida is authorized to enter into contracts with the above companies on the above items described. The above resolution was unanimously adopted by vote of the councilmen present.

Motion by Councilman Gordon Gibson and seconded by L. P. Disharoon to publish the Cinco Bayou Zoning ordinance one time in the Playground News, Fort Walton Beach, Florida, for the purpose of giving more recent public notice of the zoning requirements.
