

Town of Cinco Bayou Council Meeting  
March 3, 1970

The Cinco Bayou Town Council met at 7:30 p.m. with the following members present: Mayor Lowell Taylor; Council members Irene Balsley, Iva Booher Paul Hutchison, Edward Laritz, and Harold Peek; Attorney Estergren.

Mayor Taylor called the meeting to order with prayer.

The minutes of the February meeting were called for and read. The motion made by Councilman Laritz and seconded by Councilman Balsley to accept the minutes as read, carried unanimously.

Councilman Balsley stated, Buildings must be inspected to be rated before being insured. Councilman Balsley had contacted the Allstate Insurance Agent.

The Financial Report was read. Council man Peek made the motion to accept the financial report. The motion was seconded by Councilman Hutchison and carried.

A statement was made, we still have some old christmas lights up.

Question was asked, if a Semi-Annual Reprot was available and answered, no.

Attorney Estergren was asked to contact the county commissioners to see if Cinco would be able to hook onto the county sewer system. This would be paid for by General Avenue.

A little from Mr. Freeman of Moore Handley requested the Council to consider the possibility of a traffic light on Eglin Parkway at Hughes Avenue. The letter was read and tabled for future consideration.

The north west corner of Eglin Parkway and Yacht Club Road was discussed as being driving hazard for large vehicles proceeding south on Eglin Parkway and making a right turn on Yacht Club Road. The motion made by Councilman Laritz was that the clerk would write Tom Webb of the State Road Department asking their consideration of this problem. The motion was seconded by Councilman Peek and carried.

Attorney Estergren stated that there is no new information from Attorney Anderson and Okaloosa County Gas District or Mr. Freeman and Moore Handley.

The motion made by Councilman Laritz and seconded by Councilman Peek to adjourn, carried unanimously.
