

Town of Cinco Bayou Council Meeting  
March 4, 1969

Cinco Bayou Council Meeting, 7:30 p.m. Present Mayor Ronald Gibson, Councilmen Iva Booher, Paul Hutchison, Edward Laritz, and Lowell Taylor. Attorney Estergren.

Minutes of last meeting were read with corrections from stop sign to dip sign. Councilman Laritz moved to accept minutes after correction. Seconded by Councilman Taylor. Motion carried.

Finance report read by Mayor Gibson. Councilman Taylor moved to accept finance report. Seconded by Councilman Hutchison. Motion Carried.

Mayor Gibson reported he had contacted the County Commissioners about the sidewalk on Yacht Club Drive. They ask for time to consider the project. Discussion of laws on water and land, building of docks or pumping sand, which is now in force. Documents of laws on file at the town hall. Estimates, prices on paving Town Hall lot from Okaloosa Asphalt Company price received (\$900 for paving, \$350 curbs and gutters). Motion made by Councilman Taylor. Seconded by Councilman Laritz to accept the bid, Motion carried. Mayor Gibson volunteered to talk Mr. Fleming about the project.

Motion made by Councilman Hutchison, seconded by Councilman Taylor to approach the Okaloosa County Commissioners with prospects of obtaining approval of company sweeper to clear streets as needed. Approved Mayor reported on Councilman Sonnenberg who is in the V A Hospital, Lake City, Florida. A letter from Congressman Bob Sikes who helped make this possible. Councilman approval of sending flowers. A suggestion was made to get prices information for picture of former Mayor Gordon Gibson to hang in the Town Hall. Move to adjourn by Councilman Laritz, seconded by Councilman Taylor. Motion carried.
