

Town of Cinco Bayou Council Meeting  
March 5, 1968

Cinco Bayou Council Meeting, 7:30 p.m. Present Mayor Roanld Gibson, Attorney Esteegren, Councilmen Lowell Taylor, Paul Hutchison, and Iva Booher.

Minutes of the previous meeting was read. Councilman Taylor moved we accept the minutes as read, seconded by Councilman Hutchison . Motion carried.

Councilman Hutchison moved Mayor Gibwon contact the City Council of Ft Walton Bch Fire Dept concerning fire protection, seconded by Councilmna Taylor.

Attorney Estergren read the State Beverage Charter requirements to petition for a liquor license. Place of business selling alcoholic beverage to be 2500 ft from a church and population 1251 persons. Town of Cinco Bayou charter only read we had the right to prohibit the sale of liquor with no distance stated. Mayor Gibson suggested we measure distance from business place selling liquor before changing the charter.

Fianance report was read.

Councilman Taylor suggested the City Clerk contact the Humane Society to get a price on a call system. Requiring person requesting service to pay one half of fee charged and the town billed for the remaining one half.

Mayor Gibson presented direct dialing to Crestview. He suggested this be presented to Mayor Tras, president of the League of Municipalities and to suggest it to be brought up at the next municipalities regular meeting.

Councilman Booher moved we switch the stop sign on Seaway to Opp Blvd and place the yield sign on Opp Blvd to the Seaway, seconded by Councilman Taylor. Carried.

Being no further business, Councilman Hutchison mvoed we adjourn meeting, seconded by Councilman Taylor. Motion carried.
