Finance report read by Councilman Laritz. Councilman Laritz motioned we pay \$5,272.41 total omit due on building loan at the First National Bank, seconded by Councilman Hutchison. Motion carried.

Motion made by Council man Taylor the town clerk write a letter of apprication to Vernon Risher for his recent survey and prposal recommendations for a Post Office in our town, seconded by Councilman Sonnenberg. Motion carried.

Mayor appointed Councilman Laritz to get recommendations for Fish Fry and report to the next meeting.

Councilman Peek moved we have Attorney Estergren draft a letter to Watt's Marine to move boats from street. Seconded by Councilman Hutchison. Carried.

Councilman Laritz moved we repaint and erect signs on Seaway to indicate Public parking area, seconded by Councilman Taylor. Motion carried.
