In conversation with Chief Sansom of the Ocean City/Wright Fire District, Chief Sansom suggested the Town to pay a fire department in order to get quality as he did not feel there were enough night residents in the Town to staff a volunteer department. He suggested we would need at least ten certified employees, two pumpers at a cost of \$45,000 each, and a building.

The Ocean City/Wright Fire Department is zoned eight while the Fort Walton Beach Fire Department is zoned six. Cinco Bayou is in zone ten. (Ratings are for insurance purposes.)

Mayor Smith and Councilman Johnston volunteered to go to the Fort Walton Beach City Council to get a bid from them for service to Cinco Bayou.

The clerk was ask to bring a job description for a deputy clerk, (for the purpose of publication to employment service.)

Mayor Smith stated the need for "Swim at your own risk" signs to be placed in the water-front parks and Councilwoman Booher made the motion to secure signs. Mayor Smith stated he would get bids for the signs. The motion was seconded by Councilwoman Balsley and the motion carried.
