Therefore, a quorum being present, Mayor Smith opened the meeting with silent prayer at 7:35 p.m.

1. MINUTES - SPECIAL MEETING - JANUARY 24, 1975. Motion to approve as presented by Mr. Peek, seconded by Mrs. Balsley carried unanimously.
2. MINUTES - REGULAR MEETING - FEBRUARY 13, 1975. Motion to approve as presented by Mrs. Balsley, seconded by Mr. Peek carried unanimously.
3. MINUTES - SPECIAL MEETING - FEBRUARY 27, 1975. Motion to approve as presented by Mr. Peek, seconded by Mrs. Balsley carried unanimously.
4. FINANCIAL STATEMENT - FEBRUARY 1975. Mr. Johnston questioned checks 1254, 1259, and 1266. After being satisfied on each, Mrs. Balsley motioned to approve statement as presented, with a second from Mr. Johnston. Motion carried unanimously.
5. PRESENTATION - OKALOOSA COUNCIL OF THE AGED. This item by-passed as no one showed up to make the presentation.
6. ORDINANCE - 2ND READING - AMENDMENT TO ALLOW BEER & WINE TO BE SERVED IN RESTAURANTS. Mr. Peek motioned to approve the 2nd reading with Mr. Johnston seconding. 8. REQUEST FOR BUILDING PERMIT - FIRST FEDERAL. Attorney stated he could not find anything wrong with the paperwork First Federal had submitted. Mr. Peek moved that a building permit be issued with a second by Mr. Johnston. Motion carried unanimously.
9. COMMITTEE APPOINTMENT - FOR SEWER ORDINANCE. Mayor Smith appointed Mr. Johnston and Mrs. Balsley to work on the sewer ordinance. Mr. Johnston to be Chairman.
