Attorney McInnis asked to meet with them at their convenience to discuss the Sunshine Law and other related legal matters that will affect them as Councilmembers.


WORKSHOP

1. Town Manager/Clerk Selection

Attorney McInnis outlined the proposed process for the selection of the Town Manager and the Council's roll in the process. Attorney McInnis asked to be excused at this time. Following a short discussion concerning the process, Mayor Drabczuk asked each Councilmember to present their choice of the applicants. After each Councilmember presented their choices, the Council selected the top six candidates from the list. The top six selected from the thirty-nine applicants were Michael L. Brillhart, David W. Linger, Beth McHenry, Gerald J. Mussak, Harry F. Norman and Jason L. Yarborough. Councilman Payne made a motion to accept the top six candidates, seconded by Councilman Kendrick. During the discussion, Councilman Skelly made an amendment to the motion to add Mr. James R. Knight to the list. Councilman Payne said he would accept Councilman Skelly's amendment. Councilwoman Carroll then made an amendment to the motion to add Mr. Charles Turner to the list. Councilman Payne accepted Councilwoman Carroll's amendment. Following a short discussion, the motion was unanimously approved.

Mayor Drabczuk advised the Council that the date and time for the interviews would be established at the next Council meeting, April 9, 1998.

There being no further business, the workshop adjourned the meeting at 6:35 PM.
