

Town of Cinco Bayou, Fl  
Special Council Meeting Minutes  
March 28, 1996

1. Mayor Drabczuk called the meeting to order at 5:00 p.m. this date. Following silent prayer and the pledge of allegiance to the flag, roll call was taken.

3. Public Hearing: First reading of Ordinance No. 167 amendments to the Parks and Recreation Ordinance of the Town.

Manager Bell informed the Council that public notice of the special Council meeting had been and the session now open is a proper one for discussion and action on the agenda item listed.

Mayor Drabczuk gave a brief opening statement then opened the Public Hearing. The following persons addressed the Council: Michael B. Smith, Jerry Carroll, Donald E. Olsen, Patrick L. Foght, Darrell D. Chinn and Dennis Brown.

After calling for any additional public comment, and hearing none, the Mayor closed the Public Hearing.

Councilwoman Frey made a motion to approve the first reading of Ordinance No. 167, seconded by Councilwoman Leach. Councilwoman Frey then offered some amendments to the Ordinance. Councilwoman Leach withdrew her second to the motion until all amendments were included in the motion. After Council discussion, Councilwoman Frey restated her motion to approve the first reading of Ordinance No. 167 with the following amendments:

(Amendment No. 1). Section 15-31 (h) Bicycles (3). This paragraph, which prohibited additional riders on bicycles, was deleted and re-numbered.

(Amendment No. 2). Section 15-32 (b) Boating added paragraph (3) to wit: Prohibition of repair or maintenance. Perform boat or engine repair or maintenance except in emergency situations.

(Amendment No. 3). Section 15-34 Merchandising, advertising and signs. (a) Vending and peddling. Added new prefacing words Solicit for any purpose, expose or offer for sale any article or thing, nor shall he station or place any stand, cart, or vehicle for the transportation, sale or display of any such article or thing. Exception is here made as to any regularly licensed concessionaire action by and under the authority and regulation of the Town.


(Amendment No. 4) Section 15-34 Merchandising, advertising and signs, deleted (b) regarding advertising and re-lettered remaining section.

(Amendment No. 5) Section 15-35 Park operating Policy, added clarifying language to (c) Permit, to wit: A permit shall be obtained from the Town before participating in a group activity composed of twenty (20) or more persons, not including the activity of loading or unloading boats or recreational vehicles.

(Amendment No. 6) Section 15-35 Park operating policy (1) g) added non-refundable provision to wit: All applicants desiring to obtain a permit for exclusive use of any portion of a park, will be required to pay a non-refundable fee of forty dollars (\$40.00) at the time of issuance. Councilwoman Leach seconded the motion. It was approved unanimously.

Members of the audience, Mr. Carroll, Mr. Brown and Mr. Chinn asked for clarification of the Ordinance. Their concerns were responded to by the Mayor.

There being no further business, the Mayor adjourned the meeting at 6:15 P.M.
