Councilman Laritz reported on fire protection for the town and suggested we leave protection as it is at the present time and not enter a contract.

Councilman Taylor moved we approve ordinance for cigarette tax increase from 8¢ to 11¢. Seconded by Councilman Laritz. Carried.

Councilman Booher moved we paint garbage cans with letters at Laguna Park seconded by Councilman Laritz. Carried. Councilman Laritz moved we clean-up our city streets, seconded by Councilman Taylor. Carried. Councilman Laritz moved we pay Roy Helgeson \$15 for removal of tree at Laguna Park, seconded by Councilman Hutchison. Carried. Council Hutchison moved we contribute \$100 to the Doolittle Fund, seconded by Councilman Taylor. Carried.

Being further, no further business, Councilman Laritz moved we adjourn meeting, seconded by Councilman Taylor. Carried.
