The meeting was called to order by the Mayor. Minutes read and approved.

Mr. William Gibson gave a report on the future speed limits in Cinco Bayou. A 25mph speed limit was decided on for all streets in Cinco. The streets running East and West shall be through streets, and the North and South streets shall be yield streets.

Mr. Disharoon informed council members that some tenants in Cinco are refusing to have trash and garbage picked up. They are burning trash or depositing it on private property. He suggested that form letters containing rules, regulations, and fee for this be given to each new resident of Cinco. Each resident is required to pay per month.

It was brought to attention of council members that trucks being parked on Kelly Avenue owned by Vesta Lumber Company are a traffic hazard. Mayor Gibson will contact them and ask that trucks be parked inside lumber yard.

The new street under construction is Irwin Avenue. Completion of this project is expected by June 1, 1961.

A new council member is needed to replace vacancy left by Mr. Harmon. Mr. Gordon Gibson will consult with Mr. Rice on the usual procedure taken in such a matter. It was suggested Mr. Theodore Gibson be asked to refill this vacancy.

All business accomplished the meeting adjourned.
