1. Minutes - March 6 and March 14, 1990 - Councilman Gage made a motion for approval and acceptance of the minutes for March 6th and 14th, 1990, seconded by Councilman Broxson. The motion was unanimously approved.

2. Deposits and Payments - March, 1990 - Councilwoman Dumka made a motion to accept the list of Deposits and Payments for March, 1990, seconded by Councilman Skelly. The motion was unanimously approved.

3. Code Enforcement Board Nominations - Mayor Laginess commented on how well the Code Enforcement Seminar was presented. Attorney McInnis agreed and stated there was a possibility of having another Code Enforcement meeting here targeting specific groups of people. There being no nominations to the Code Enforcement Board, Mayor Laginess tabled this item until the next meeting.

4. Employee Insurance - Secretary Dole presented a brief synopsis of a Town Employee insurance proposal. The Council agreed to table this item to allow Secretary Dole time to obtain proposals with higher deductibles for comparison.

Mayor Laginess reported that DOT has not yet received the money from Tallahassee for the crosswalk at Eglin Parkway and Yacht Club Drive. DOT will proceed as soon as the money is allocated.

COUNCILMEMBERS REPORTS/COMMENTS

Councilwoman Buchanan asked about replacing the tree that Gulf Power had "trimmed" with the fine money.

Mayor Laginess asked the Council to consider some kind of memorial plaque for Phil Johnston.

Councilman Gage commented that during Spring Clean-up, a lot of the refuse came from outside of Cinco Bayou. Mayor Laginess stated they would look into other ways to handle the clean-up in the future.


