

Town of Cinco Bayou Council Meeting
May 2, 1967

Cinco Bayou Council Meeting, 7:30 p.m. Present Mayor Ronald Gibson, Attorney Estergren, Councilmen Paul Hutchison, Harold Peek, Lowell Taylor, Peter Sonnenberg, and Edward Laritz.

Minutes of the previous meeting were read. Councilmen Peek moved we accept minutes as read, seconded by Councilman Edward Laritz. Approved.

Finance report for April was given.

Discussion on contacting the Humane Society. Mayor Gibson requested Attorney Estergren to draft a letter as an agreement to pay \$25 per month and send a copy to the society for approval.

Discussion on black topping Hughes Avenue to Beal Street. Mayor Gibson met with Fort Walton to find out when they would feel it feasible to start the project. Drainage seems to be the major consideration.

Councilman Laritz moved we reimburse Mayor Gibson for telephone charges to Congress Sikes in reference to establishing a new Post Office in our town, seconded by Councilman Hutchison. Motion carried.

Councilman Laritz moved we pay all business calls made for the town. Seconded by Councilman Taylor. Motion carried.

Mayor Gibson appointed Mrs. Booher to be chairman of Cinco Flag. She is to report back at the next meeting.

Councilman Laritz, chairman of the Fish Fry reports he will serve slaw. Councilman Hutchison volunteered to distribute invitations to all Cinco residents for the Fish Fry to be held at the dedication of our Town Hall, May 30 from 6 to 8 p.m. Councilman Taylor moved we make final arrangements for the fish fry. Seconded by Councilman Hutchison. Motion carried.

Councilman Peek moved we get an estimate to black top Opp Blvd from Troy Avenue to Opp Blvd, Kelly Avenue from Troy Street to intersection of Opp Blvd, seconded by Councilman Hutchison. Carried.

Councilman Laritz moved we adjourn meeting. Seconded by Councilman Hutchison. Motion Approved.
