Cinco Bayou Council Meeting 7:30 p.m. Present Mayor Roanal Gibson, Attorney Estergren, Councilmen Iva Booher, Lowell Taylor, Paul Hutchison, and Edward Laritz.

Councilman Laritz to obtain prices on the cost of sidewalks per sq. yd. for Yacht Club Drive by the June Meeting.

Councilman maritz moved to grant an exclusive franchise to Ralph W. Sibert to hall city garbage to begin Sept 30, 1969 on termination of Allen Davis contract. Seconded by Councilman Booher. Motion carried.

Councilman Hutchison moved to order a load of cold asphalt from Okaloosa Asphalt Company to repairs streets. Seconded by Councilman Taylor. Motion carried. Councilman Taylor moved to accept complaints and stand responsibility if street sweeper could be used to clean the streets. Seconded by Councilman Laritz. Motion carried.
