

Town of Cinco Bayou Council Meeting
May 5, 1970

The Town Council of Cinco Bayou met at 7:30 p.m. with the following present: Mayor Lowell Taylor, Attorney Estergren, and Council members Irene Balsley, Iva Booher, Paul Hutchison, and Harold Peek.

Mayor Taylor requested the meeting to begin with silent prayer.

The minutes for the March and April meetings were called for and read. The motion made by Councilman Booher and seconded by Councilman Hutchison to accept the minutes as read was approved.

The Finance Report for the months of March and April were read and the motion to accept the reports as read by Councilman Peek and seconded by Councilman Balsley was approved.

Other items of business discussed were: (1) Insurance for the Town Hall - The building has not been inspected, therefore a bid has not been made. Members of Council volunteered to check on bids. (2) A letter has been received from Tom Webb of the State Road Department acknowledging our letter concerning the turning radii of the north west corner of Yacht Club Road and Eglin Parkway. The State Road Department will be considering this corner. (3) Attorney Estergren was ask to contact persons in charge of the South Okaloosa County Sewer System concerning a connection to their sewage system for Cinco Bayou.

The motion made by Councilman Booher and seconded by Councilman Peek to adjourn, carried unanimously.
