



4. Eglin Parkway Resolution. The Mayor asked the Council to review the resolution of the City of Fort Walton Beach for the resurfacing of Eglin Parkway, and to consider a Town of Cinco Bayou resolution also supporting Eglin Parkway resurfacing.

#### PUBLIC REQUESTS

Mr. Dumka told the Council that he would like to be considered for the vacancy on the Council.

#### COMMITTEE REPORTS

1. Streets/Sidewalks/Crime Watch - Councilman Davis.

A. Parking on the Sidewalks. The Mayor advised the Council that the "No Parking on Sidewalks" signs had been placed and he believed that an ordinance would be required for enforcement. Councilwoman Kelley suggested that Salamander notify the Okaloosa County Sheriff's Department when cars were parked on the sidewalks and have the Okaloosa County Sheriff's Department issue a citation. Mayor Usrey appointed Councilman Davis to resolve the matter.

B. Eglin Parkway/Yacht Club Intersection. The Council was given a handout of the County's proposal on one method of improving the traffic flow through the Eglin Parkway and Yacht Club Intersection. The Mayor asked the Council to study the handout and be ready to discuss it at the Regular Council Meeting.

2. Parks/Beautification/Environment - Councilwoman Kelley. No report. The Clerk advised the Council that the swimming area in Laguna Park had been tested by the County Health Department and rated fair. Frances Park and the boat ramp were not tested.

3. Finance - Councilman Peek. No report.

4. Waterfront/Bayou/Health/Civil Defense - Councilman Perry.

A. Boat Ramp. Mayor Usrey asked the Council to read the handout which included all material from the past minutes concerning the boat ramp. At this point, Mr. Phil Auer, Auer Marine, stated that he had spoken to several of the Commissioners and that the County could repair and maintain the boat ramp. This was followed by a short discussion, and will be discussed at the Regular Council Meeting.

5. Zoning and Building Codes. No report.

6. Utilities - Mayor Usrey. This item was covered under Regular Buisness, Item 1.

CLERK'S REPORT


