Disharoon and seconded by Elbert Davis that the City Attorney contact the State Road Department and request that they deed or dedicate to the Town of Cinco Bayou that strip of land between the new Cinco Bayou Bridge (Five Mile) and the property of Phil Johnston for use as a sea-way or launching ramp for the general public.




Discussion concerning proposed water franchise with Fort Walton Beach, Florida.
