HURRICANE PREPAREDNESS WORKSHOP MINUTES
May 24, 2007 – 5:00 PM

Mayor Iovieno called the Hurricane Preparedness Workshop meeting to order at 5:00 P.M. on Thursday, May 24, 2007. Following a silent prayer and the pledge of allegiance, roll call was taken:

Also present at the meeting were: Town Manager/Clerk Nell Webb and Assistant Town Manager/Clerk Monika Gillette.

Mayor Iovieno explained the purpose of the meeting was to continue the Town's hurricane preparedness discussions. Mayor Iovieno suggested specific newsletters for Hurricane Preparedness to be delivered to residents. The newsletter should include contact information. It was the consensus of the council to divide the town into two areas one east and one west of Eglin Parkway and assign primary and secondary contacts before each storm event. Due to where they live, Councilmen Bratton, Koch and Chubb will be assigned to the area west of Eglin Parkway and Mayor Iovieno and Councilmen Farley and Caforio to the area east of Eglin Parkway. Council members made suggestions for the newsletter stressing tips that would be beneficial to residents.
