

Town of Cinco Bayou Council Meeting
June 3, 1969

Cinco Bayou Council Meeting, 7:30 p.m. Present Mayor Ronald Gibson Attorney Estergren, Councilmen Peter Sonnenberg, Lowell Taylor, Iva Booher, and Edward Laritz.

Minutes of the last meeting was read. Councilman Sonnenberg moved the minutes be accepted as read. Seconded by Councilman Booher. Motion carried.

Councilman Taylor moved the monthly finance report be accepted as read. Seconded by Councilman Sonnenberg. Motion carried.

Councilman Laritz contacted four contractors and got prices on side walks \$1.40 - \$1.50 per running ft. installed, including forms, curbs, and a poured finished job. Mayor Gibson suggested to get several bids to start the sidewalk program. Councilman Laritz moved to get sealed bids for sidewalks from Eglin Parkway, west to city limits toward Beal Parkway minus paved areas. Seconded by Councilman Taylor. Motion carried.

Mayor Gibson appointed Councilman Taylor to contact the State Road Department to get a survey concerning right-away for new sidewalks.

Mrs. Cramer volunteered to plant shrubs on west front side of City Hall to close drive way.

Councilman Laritz moved Marshal Disharoon contact Mr. Frazier advising him that Allen Davis has the exclusive contract in the city to haul trash and garbage. Second by Councilman Taylor. Motion carried.

Mayor Gibson reported the County Commissioners would consider giving as much aid as possible after their fiscal year ending July 1. Drafting monies from the secondary funds for drainage of Hughes Avenue.

Council Booher moved we adjourn the meeting. Seconded by Councilman Taylor. Motion carried.
