Mayor Usrey requested the Clerk to call the roll.




Proposal for Kidd Street Curb and Paving Project. Mayor Usrey read the proposal to the Council and a short discussion followed. Councilman Davis moved that the Council accept the proposal from Junger Paving in the amount of \$9,225.75. The project will include curb and paving for 200' of Kidd street and curb and storm drain repair on Lucile Street. In the discussion, the motion was amended to include 90% of the total cost would be paid on completion and the remaining 10% held until after publication of the project completion notice. The motion was seconded by Councilman Johnston and carried unanimously on a roll call vote.
