

Town of Cinco Bayou Council Meeting
June 4, 1964

Present Mayor Gordon Gibson, Attorney Fred Estergren, Councilmen Ronald Gibson, Ed Laritz, Paul Hutchison. Committee on rezoning Jim Kendrick, Phil Johnston, and visitor-Edith Fry.

Minutes of previous meeting read and approved.

Petition of Harold C. Medlin and wife, Louise Medlin and James H. Langston and wife, Margaret L. Langston for vacating alley between Irvin Street, and Garnett Avenue, west of Block 14. Ronald Gibson made motion to grant petition, seconded by Ed Laritz. Motion carried.

Petition of Phil Johnston for vacating alley in Block 2 according to plot of Cinco Bayou subdivision duly recorded in the public records of Okaloosa County Florida said petition being the owner of the property described. Laritz made motion to grant petition, seconded by Hutchison. Motion carried.

Recommendation by Survey Committee to contract with Gulf Power Co., for eighteen street lights at \$49.28 per month. Ronald Gibson made motion to accept the recommendation, seconded by Ed Laritz. Motion carried.

Report by committee on re-zoning according to city of Cinco Bayou Charter, zoning areas being R1-C2-C1-Mayor stated there would be a public hearing on the change in zoning.

Mayor Gibson ask for an OK to mail permission to man, to submit his building plans on Lot 3 Block 27 which were to be in by July 1 to hold his contract. Permission was granted provided he would abide by the zoning ordinance and regulation which have not been voted on. Laritz made motion to adjourn, seconded by Hutchison. Motion carried.
