B. Speed Bumps - Kelly Avenue. After a lengthy discussion Attorney Powell suggested to Council that we contact Sheriff Gilbert for assistance in slowing down the speedsters on Kelly Avenue. He suggested that possibly the Sheriff could send a deputy to watch the traffic during peak hours. Councilman Usrey was not in favor of speed bumps being constructed on Kelly Avenue. Mayor Pro Tem Perry directed Clerk Borchik to check with Sheriff Gilbert and see if he can assist us.

PARKS/BEAUTIFICATION/ENVIRONMENT - COUNCILWOMAN KELLEY. No report.

FINANCE - COUNCILMAN PEEK.

A. Budget Status/Revision. Clerk Borchik reported to Council that approximately \$8,000.00 over budget will be required to pay sewer bills for the remainder of the FY. He also advised Council that he would have a proposed revision to the budget for next Monday's meeting.

On another matter, he advised the Council that Gulf Power had accepted the Franchise and we have received the first check for franchise fees.

WATERFRONT/BAYOU/HEALTH - COUNCILMAN PERRY.

A. Boat Ramp. Councilwoman Kelley requested that we take the concrete ramps recently removed from the boat launch and construct one ramp to handle the big boats. Mayor Pro Tem Perry appointed Councilwoman Kelley as Chairperson of a committee, along with Engineer Burt, to study the cost, etc., of fixing the boat ramp.

UTILITIES - COUNCILMAN USREY. No report.

7. CLERK'S REPORT.

A. Hughes/Opp Ditch. The Hughes/Opp ditch is completed. The Town has planted some greenery to landscape this area. Mr. Godwin has requested the Town to repair that part of the driveway that was damaged during the construction. The Clerk will discuss this with him this week.

B. Glenwood Park Access Road. Clerk Borchik requested Councils' permission to have the lot surveyed that serves as access to Glenwood Park. Mayor Pro Tem Perry directed Clerk Borchik to obtain cost estimates for a survey for next week's meeting.

C. Recording/Amplifier System for Town Hall. After a brief discussion, Councilman Usrey requested that Clerk Borchik be able to purchase whatever equipment he deems necessary. Clerk Borchik will obtain costs to present to Council.

D. Agenda Policy. After a brief discussion, no decision was made.

E. Flag. Mayor Pro Tem Perry advised Council that this would be on the agenda for the regular meeting for approval.

8. ANNOUNCEMENTS.

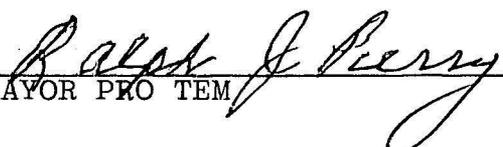
A. Town Picnic, June 16, 1981. The Town Picnic will be held at Laguna Park at 6:30 P.M., June 16, 1981.

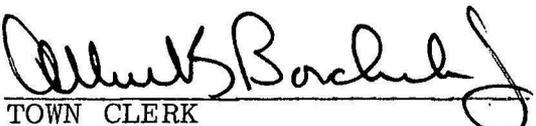
