PUBLIC HEARING

Ordinance No. 154 - Second reading and proposed adoption of Ordinance No. 154, an Ordinance amending Section 1, Ordinance No. 153. Attorney McInnis read Ordinance No 154 by title only. Councilman Gage made a motion to accept the second reading of Ordinance No 154, seconded by Councilman Broxson. The motion was unanimously approved. Councilman Gage then made a motion to adopt Ordinance No 154, seconded by Councilwoman Balsley. The motion was unanimously approved.

Councilwoman Balsley announced that she was resigning her Town Council position effective June 30, 1993, due to ill health. She asked that the Council consider Mr Tom Leach as her replacement. Mr Leach has volunteered to serve on the Council. Attorney McInnis advised the Council that upon receipt of Mrs Balsley's resignation, filling her vacancy would be placed on the July Town Council meeting agenda.

Councilman Kendrick arrived at this time.

Councilman Gage advised the Council that the Panhandle League of Cities is sponsoring an Institute for Elected Municipal Officials at the Robert F. Sikes Library on July 23 - 25, 1993. The Panhandle League of Cities will pay the Institute registration fee for all members of the Panhandle League who attend. A registration form has been given each elected official.

There being no further business, the meeting adjourned at 5:07 PM.

ORDINANCE NO. 154

AN ORDINANCE OF TOWN OF CINCO BAYOU, FLORIDA, AMENDING SECTION 1, ORDINANCE NO. 153

WHEREAS, the Town Council determined that it is in the best interest of the public to adopt Ordinance No. 153 thereby granting an exclusive franchise to Environmental Waste Systems in order to provide garbage and trash service at reasonable rates to the residents and businesses of the Town of Cinco Bayou, Florida; and,

WHEREAS, the Town Council has determined that industrial roll-off container service should not be included in the exclusive franchise agreement.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED BY THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF CINCO BAYOU, FLORIDA, THAT:

Section 1. Section 1, Ordinance No. 153 is hereby amended to read as follows:

"Section 1. That the Town Council of the Town of Cinco Bayou, Florida, hereinafter called "Town", does hereby grant to Environmental Waste Systems, hereinafter called "Contractor", the right, privilege, easement and exclusive franchise to operate the sanitary garbage service for the collection and disposal of residential and commercial garbage, trash and yard waste within the corporate limits of the Town. Industrial "Roll-off" service can be provided to customers within the Town through open competition."

Section 2. Severability. If any word, sentence, phrase, clause, section or portion of this ordinance shall be held invalid or unconstitutional by a court of competent jurisdiction, such portion of words shall be deemed a separate and independent provision and such holding shall not effect the validity of the remaining portion thereof.

Section 3. Repeal of Conflicting Ordinances and Resolutions. All ordinances and resolutions of the governing body in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

Section 4. Effective Date. This ordinance shall become effective immediately upon its final passage and adoption.
