

5. LEAGUE OF CITIES DINNER. Mayor Pro Tem Perry advised Council that the League of Cities Dinner will be held at the Eglin Officers Club, Thursday, July 23, 1981, Cocktails at 6:30 and the Seafood Buffet at 7:30. Mr. Milligan, Secretary of the League, will prepare and mail invitations. As Cinco Bayou is the Host, each member should plan to attend.
6. GLENWOOD PARK ACCESS ROAD SURVEY. Clerk Borchik advised Council that of the four surveyors contacted, Mr. Overstreet was the only one to provide a cost estimate to do the survey. Cost is \$150.00. Councilman Peek moved that we authorize Mr. Overstreet to survey the lot, seconded by Councilman Davis. The motion carried unanimously.
7. CHAMBER OF COMMERCE MEMBERSHIP DUES. Councilman Davis moved that we renew our membership in the amount of \$125.00 with the proviso that in the future, the Chamber give Cinco Bayou some recognition, seconded by Councilwoman Kelley. The motion carried unanimously.
8. ATTORNEY'S REPORT - GLENWOOD PARK. Attorney Powell reported to Council that a hearing had been held last week on Mr. Stewart's motion in behalf of Mr. Pryor for a judgment on the pleadings. Mr. Stewart had filed a motion to amend the pleadings by affixing three affidavits to Mr. Pryor's claim. Judge Tolton denied the motion and set the pre-trial for September, and scheduled the trial for late September or early October.
9. FLAG PURCHASE. Councilwoman Kelley moved that we purchase a new flag, seconded by Councilman Peek. The motion carried unanimously.

10. COMMITTEE REPORTS.

STREETS/SIDEWALKS - COUNCILMAN DAVIS

A. Sidewalks - Survey and Proposed Construction. Councilman Davis advised Council that priorities should be established for the construction of the sidewalks. He recommended that Yacht Club Drive be given first priority, Troy Street second priority and Opp Street, third priority. After a brief discussion, Councilman Davis moved to go ahead with Yacht Club Drive and Troy Street, seconded by Councilman Usrey. The motion carried unanimously.

B. Speed Bumps - Kelly Avenue. After a brief discussion Councilman Peek moved that the Town purchase signs saying "Slow - Children Playing" and install on Kelly Avenue, seconded by Mr. Davis. The motion carried unanimously.

PARKS/BEAUTIFICATION/ENVIRONMENT - COUNCILWOMAN KELLEY. No report.

FINANCE - COUNCILMAN PEEK. No report.

WATERFRONT/BAYOU/HEALTH - COUNCILMAN PERRY

A. Boat Ramp. Councilwoman Kelley, chairperson of the committee, advised Council that Engineer Burt will prepare an estimate for putting the slips back together for the large boats to use.

UTILITIES - COUNCILMAN USREY. No report.

11. CLERK'S REPORT.

A. Clerk Borchik attended the Hurricane Exercise on June 11. Although the Exercise was beneficial, some areas still require attention. According to the present plan, no emergency equipment or manpower will be positioned at the Eglin/Yacht Club intersection. This will be discussed with Mr. Nichols.

B. Town Cleaning of Right-of-Way. Clerk Borchik requested Council's position on cleaning the right-of-way. After a short discussion, Council directed Clerk Borchik to send letters to the individuals who have bushes and other types of hazards to cut the trees or bushes back in order not to create a driving hazard.

12. ANNOUNCEMENTS.


A. Mayor Pro Tem Perry advised Council the Town Picnic will be held at 6:30 on June 16, 1981.
