

Town of Cinco Bayou Council Meeting
July 7, 1970

The meeting of the Town Council of Cinco Bayou was called to order with prayer by Mayor Lowell Taylor.

Persons present were Councilmembers Iva Booher, Paul Hutchison and Edward Laritz, and Attorney Fred Estergren.

The minutes were read and the motion to accept the minutes as read, by Councilman Laritz and seconded by Councilman Booher. Council members discussed the need for coal patch to repair roads. Councilman Laritz made a motion, seconded by Councilman Hutchison to purchase three yards of coal patch (one for Mrs. Booher included). Motion carried.

Council members noted that the county commissioners did not approve of Cinco's Bayou plan to connect to the county sewer system at this time. (No sewer without water).

Mayor Taylor indicated that a personal survey shows that Cinco Bayou has ninety one trailers and apartments, fifty-one businesses and seventy-one homes. A total of two hundred and thirteen.

The Financial Report was given. The motion to accept the report made by Councilman Booher and seconded by Councilman Hutchison passed.

A letter received from the Greater First Walton Beach Chamber of Commerce requesting the Council to name representative to a seat on the board of the Chamber of Commerce, was and tabled for future action by mutual consent.

The motion of Councilman Laritz and seconded by Councilman Booher to adjourn.
