

TOWN OF GINCO BAYOU
REGULAR COUNCIL MEETING
July 10, 1975

Town officials in attendance: Mayor Harold K. Smith, Council members Irene Balsley, Iva Booher, Jim Kendrick, and Harold Peek: Attorney Rick Powell and Recorder Dee Rouse. Absent: Councilman Phil Johnston and Marshal Elliott.

Also present were: Mr. Williams and Mrs. Mills representing Warner Cable and Mrs. Crawford.

Therefore a quorum being presented, Mayor Smith opened the meeting with silent prayer at 7:35 p.m.

1. MINUTES - REGULAR COUNCIL MEETING - JUNE 12, 1975. Motion to approve as presented by Mr. Peek, seconded by Mrs. Booher. Motion carried unanimously.
2. FINANCIAL STATEMENT - JUNE 1975. Motion to approve as presented, by Mrs. Balsley, seconded by Mr. Peek. Motion carried unanimously.
3. FIRST READING - ORDINANCE AMENDING FRANCHISE WITH WARNER CABLE. Attorney Powell explained to Council that changes agreed upon at the Tuesday night work session had been incorporated in the ordinance. Mr. Peek moved to have the first reading with second from Mr. Kendrick. Motion carried unanimously. Attorney Powell performed the first reading. Clerk indicated a motion would be required to extend the present franchise until the second reading and adoption of ordinance. Mr. Kendrick moved to extend the franchise until August 14th, seconded by Mr. Peek. Motion carried unanimously.
4. UP-DATE ON EASEMENTS - THIRD ADDITION TO SEWER SYSTEM. Attorney Powell informed Council that he had not received replies from property owners on the easements requested. He further indicated that originally he has sent easement request to the Philadelphia office of Food Fair Inc., but was informed that the real estate office located in Miami would have to be contacted, and that he had forwarded the necessary paperwork to them.
5. CHAIRS FOR COUNCIL AND MAYOR. Mr. Kendrick moved that Clerk be authorized to purchase swivel chairs for the council table and folding chairs with cushion seats for the use of persons attending the meetings. Mr. Peek seconded and motion carried unanimously.
6. STOP SIGNS ON TROY STREET AT IRWIN AVENUE. Mayor Smith informed Council that he had authorized the placement of Stop sign on the West side of Troy at Irwin. After discussion, Mrs. Booher moved that a stop sign be placed on the East side of Troy at Irwin, seconded by Mr. Kendrick. Motion carried unanimously.
7. REOPENING OF LAGUNA PARK. Mrs. Balsley inquired about the reopening of Laguna Park. Mayor Smith indicated that some work remained to be done but expected completion in the near future.
8. ADJOURNMENT. Meeting adjourned at 8:40 p.m.
