MANAGERS REPORT – JUL 2003

- 1) **WASTE MANAGEMENT RECEPTACLES:** Mr. Cassidy will be in Cinco Bayou on Thursday, July 10th for final details of the contract renewal.
- 2) **GLENWOOD PARK PHASES I & II:** Contracts have been signed – DEP permits have been received – applications have been submitted to the County.
- 3) **LAGUNA PARK:** Contracts have been signed – DEP permits have been received – applications have been submitted to the County.
- 4) **VERIZON TOWER PROJECT:** Comprehensive Plan amendment recommendations will be submitted for council approval.
- 5) **SEAWAY BOAT LAUNCH:** DEP permits have been received and application has been submitted to the County.
- 6) **STREET PAVING ESTIMATES:** Dave Pavlock from Florida Highway Products called Wednesday to say they will be starting a street project with Valparaiso next month and if we were ready we could piggy-back with them to get the crack seal done. The estimate on that is \$2,000 but will probably be less. It is my recommendation that we go ahead and get that done and budget for the Micro-Surfacing next winter. We will be able to piggy-back off Valparaiso for that also. It recommended that the Micro-Surfacing be done in the colder months.
- 7) **DELAPITATED PROPERTIES:** Deputy Hawley has taken pictures and is compiling a list.
- 8) **WITHHOLDING OF BOATING IMPROVING FUNDS BY THE COUNTY:** I received a phone call from the Department of Game and Fish in response to the emails I had sent to Senator Clary. He had requested that they investigate the legality of the Policy passed by the County to withhold Boating Improvement Funds received from the sale of watercraft registrations. From their investigation it was determined that the County was in compliance with Florida Status.
