

4. OCCUPATIONAL LICENSES. The Clerk reported that two (2) individuals who are in business in the Town have not purchased an occupational license. Certified letters have been sent and received by each and neither has taken any action to secure a license. A lengthy discussion followed covering the alternatives available to the Town to enforce the ordinance. Mr Perry agreed to talk with Mr Tooke and report to council at the next meeting - no action on Mr Morgan's license.
5. CLEARING/CLEANING OF LOTS. Notices have been sent by certified mail to all those property owners who have property in violation of Section 8 of the Code of Ordinances. Most have taken some action; however, a few have done nothing toward complying with the ordinance. The council agreed that the procedures outlined in the ordinance should be followed and the Clerk was directed to prepare the required resolution for the next meeting.
6. WEST FLORIDA REGIONAL PLANNING COUNCIL BUDGET. Following a short discussion, Mayor Balsley requested each councilmember be provided a copy of the WFRPC Budget to study prior to the next meeting.
7. LEAGUE OF CITIES CONVENTION AD. Discussed and will be decided upon at next meeting.

8. COMMITTEE REPORTS.

STREETS/SIDEWALKS - COUNCILMAN DAVIS

A. Status of Survey for Sidewalks. Mr Burt displayed a drawing with the proposed sidewalk locations for the Town. Mr. Davis reminded Council that the first priority was to place sidewalks along Yacht Club Drive and Troy Street. Polyengineering will begin the survey work this week.

PARKS/BEAUTIFICATION/ENVIRONMENT - COUNCILWOMAN KELLEY

A. Status of Boat Ramp. Mrs Kelley, as chairman of the Boat Ramp Committee, presented the V&F Excavating proposal to repair the ramp; i.e., make one side fully serviceable with previous concrete strips fastened together with stainless steel bands. Mr Burt will attempt to get additional proposals for repair.

FINANCE - COUNCILMAN PEEK. The council has copies of the proposed budget revision for FYE 1981 and the proposed budget for FYE 1982. Mayor Balsley suggested that the council consider a special meeting for an item by item review of the budget. In the discussion that followed, the Clerk pointed out that before the budget revision could be discussed, a decision on capital expenditures for the remainder of the year must be made. No decisions were reached and the budgets will be discussed at the next meeting.

WATERFRONT/BAYOU/HEALTH - COUNCILMAN PERRY. Mr Perry questioned the Engineer as to the status of the proposed solution to the storm sewer drainage problem. Mr Burt explained the idea to the council; however, the manhole in Leyenda Park has not been located to date. Attempts will continue toward solving this problem.

UTILITIES - COUNCILMAN USREY Councilman Usrey indicated that this topic had been addressed throughout the meeting and although it may be prudent to wait a while before pressing Fort Walton on the issue of water and sewer, the matter must be approached carefully as it could affect additional items, such as fire protection.

9. CLERK'S REPORT - Items from last Council meeting

A. Sanitation Services now has the contract to provide services to Pantry Pride. It appears that the letter from the Attorney was sufficient to produce the desired action.

B. Access to Glenwood Park from Opp Boulevard has been surveyed and will be cleaned as soon as practical.

C. The new Flag has been purchased and received.

D. The new street signs have been purchased and are in place. Speed limit signs have been put up. All Cinco Bayou streets have 20 MPH speed limits, Eglin Parkway speed limit is 30 MPH and Hughes and Yacht Club Drive are 25 MPH.

E. The letter has been written to the Sheriff; however, no reply has been received to date.

F. Request to sell excess items, Typewriter, adding machines, and gas cans. No decision.

10. ANNOUNCEMENTS

A. Notice has been received of the Trial Date for the Trial with Pryor on Glenwood Park. Date is October 26, 1981, Shalimar Courthouse.


B. League of Cities Meeting Thursday, July 23, 1981. As we are the Sponsors, should have as many there as possible.
