Mayor Laginess called the Regular Council Meeting to order at 6:05 PM.

At the request of the Town Attorney, the Public Hearings on the adoption of Ordinance No. 132 and Resolution 89-5 were cancelled and will be rescheduled for the Special Town Council Meeting on July 27, 1989.

COUNCILMEMBERS REPORTS/COMMENTS

Councilman Skelly made the following comments:

(a) Expressed concern about the activity in Glenwood Park after the park is closed. The Town Manager indicated that there had been other similar complaints. AMSEC had been contacted and was aware of the problem but could not do anything to prevent problems.

(b) Stated that he would contact the newly appointed Ft Walton Postmaster concerning the use of the old Town Hall as a Town Post Office and securing a zip code for the Town.

Mayor Laginess returned the discussion to Glenwood Park and asked the Council to approve removing approximately 20 feet of the northern end of the boardwalk to limit the access to the park. Councilman Gage, Councilman Davis and Councilwoman Dumka supported the Mayor's request while Councilwoman Buchanan and Councilman Skelly were against it stating that it would not be a permanent fix to the problem. The Town Manager will have the maintenance man remove the first 20 feet of the boardwalk as soon as possible.

PUBLIC REQUESTS - Mr E. Broxson, Kidd Bayou Oaks, expressed concern about a stormwater drainage problem on Kidd Street in front of the north driveway at Kidd Bayou Oaks Townhomes. Mayor Laginess asked the Town Engineer to look into this problem and make a recommendation to the Council as soon as possible.

The Town Engineer advised the Council that he had examined the driveway entrance at the Scofield residence and agreed that there is a problem with standing water in the driveway entrance. He indicated that he would contact contractors for their recommendations on the slution to this problem.


