

6. OCCUPATIONAL LICENSES. Mayor Pro Tem Perry advised council that he had contacted Mr. Tooke and Mr. Tooke advised him that he will try and get his license this week. Clerk Borchik advised council that Mr. Morgan, a surveyor, was not discussed at the previous meeting. Councilman Usrey moved that the ordinance be enforced, seconded by Councilman Peek. Attorney Powell advised council that according to the ordinance, we can either file a civil action or a criminal action. The motion carried unanimously. Council directed Attorney Powell to contact Mr. Tooke and Mr. Morgan.

7. CLEARING/CLEANING OF LOTS. Clerk Borchik advised council that they had directed him at the July 13, 1981 meeting to draw up a resolution. In accordance with the Code of Ordinances, the resolution must state an estimate for cost of cleaning. To date, the Clerk has been unable to obtain an estimate for the clearing/cleaning of the effected lots. After a brief discussion, Councilman Peek moved to table this item, seconded by Councilman Usrey. The motion carried unanimously.

8. WEST FLORIDA REGIONAL PLANNING COUNCIL BUDGET. After a brief discussion, Councilman Usrey moved to send \$28.00 to the West Florida Regional Planning Council, seconded by Councilman Davis. The motion carried unanimously.

9. LEAGUE OF CITIES CONVENTION AD. After a short discussion, Councilman Davis moved to take an ad in the amount of \$54.00 and be sure and emphasize that it is the Town of Cinco Bayou buying the ad, seconded by Councilwoman Kelley. The motion carried unanimously.

10. COMMITTEE REPORTS.

STREETS/SIDEWALKS - COUNCILMAN DAVIS.

A. Status of Survey for Sidewalks. Councilman Davis advised council that the engineers are working on the plans for the sidewalks on Yacht Club Drive and Troy Street, respectively. Engineer Burt advised that they would not be putting sidewalks where concrete or asphalt driveways exist but would put sidewalks where shell driveways exist. Mr. Kendrick requested Councils' consideration to write an ordinance that would require developers to provide sidewalks or paved walkways for new construction. Councilman Davis will take this under advisement.

PARKS/BEAUTIFICATION/ENVIRONMENT - COUNCILWOMAN KELLEY. No change to last week's report.

FINANCE - COUNCILMAN PEEK. Mayor Pro Tem Perry advised council that a Budget Workshop will be held on Monday, 27 July 1981 at 5:00 P.M. in the Town Hall.

WATERFRONT/BAYOU/HEALTH - COUNCILMAN PERRY. No report.

UTILITIES - COUNCILMAN USREY. No report.

11. CLERK'S REPORT.

A. Board of Adjustment members will have to be appointed during August, 1981, one individual to be appointed for three years and two individuals as alternates to serve for one year. This will be discussed at the August meetings.

B. We received a "Thank You" note from Phyl Creamer for the donations made by the Town of Cinco Bayou.

A. Florida League of Cities Convention. The 55th Annual Convention will be held in Orlando on October 22 thru 24th.


B. Intergovernmental Council meeting will be held on July 22, 1981 at 6:30 P.M. in the conference room of the County Courthouse in Shalimar.
