Engineer Joe Rector reviewed the process for applying for a FRDAP Grant for Glenwood Park specifically which would include stream restoration, storm water improvement; There are 3 different funding amounts \$50,000, 150,000 and over \$150,000. The whole park will have to be done in phases and through several grants. The grant application cycle opens early this year which starts August 3-14, 2015. There are several steps that we will need to take, survey, public hearing, etc.




