MINUTES OF COUNCIL MEETING

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Meeting was called to order by Mayor. Minutes of July 11, 1960 were read and approved.

Mr. Rice read the letter Estergren & Rice had written to the Attorney General concerning speed limits etc on Kidd Bayou and the letter of acknowledgement from the Attorney General stating that the problem was being studied.


Mr. Davis pointed out that the problem on Kidd Bayou was immediate and that ~~something should~~ there should be something the Town could be doing to protect the public while we are waiting for a reply from the Attorney General. Mr. Rice pointed out that under the present water safety law reckless operation of boats was prohibited and provided a penalty therefor, and that the Sheriff was the proper official to enforce the law as well as the local constable. Mr. Gibson stated that he would contact the Sheriff of Okaloosa County and see what could be accomplished toward the enforcement of the applicable law.

A discussion was held concerning the proposed paving of Lucille and Kitt streets. Mr. Gibson reported that the engineering survey on this work had been run and notes taken thereon, but that no stakes were set awaiting decision and action on the paving. That by purchasing supplies and material and paying labor costs, the County could put down asphalt with its machinery.

After a discussion as to bids on this work, Mr. Davis moved that the Council accept the bid of Mr. Louis Woodham as to putting down pipe, manholes, ~~and~~ curbs and gutters and grading for manholes and that the Town award him the contract for such work and proceed with the paving of this project. Mr. Disheroon seconded the motion and the voting was unanimously in favor.

While discussing the proposed project, Mr. Gibson stated that the curbs and gutters were to be the "V" type and were to be 8" X 20" for strength.

All business being accomplished, the meeting was adjourned.
