

Town of Cinco Bayou Council Meeting  
August 4, 1965

Present Mayor Gordon Gibson, Attorney Fred Estergren, Councilmen Ronald Gibson, Ed Laritz, Paul Hutchison, and Harold Peek. Four visitors were present.

Minutes read, motion to approve as read by Peek, seconded by Ronald Gibson.

Mr. Cole of Hardee's Hamberger establishment ask for pennition to install a HOSKINSON sealed flame chaupa incenerator considering this would eliminate the problem of litter, Peek motioned to grant pennition to install the incenerator, seconded by Laritz. Motion carried.

Mr. Peek reported that Mr. Smith is in position that he cannot accept the martial part of the Town of Cinco or any position of law enforcement since he is in service.

Phil Johnston was sugessted a contact. William J. Gibson requested the rezoning of Lots 2, 3, 4, in Blk 11, Cinco Bayou from residential to Class C1. This was discussed and tabled for present Council agreed to serve written notice to boat sales at Seaway Park of thirty days to completely clear the area. Laritz moitoned that the Town of Cinco submit plans and type of building for a City Hall, seconded by Ronald Gibson with prospects of borrowing money to build.
