

Town of Cinco Bayou Council Meeting
August 6, 1968

Cinco Bayou Council Meeting, 7:30 p.m. Present Mayor Ronald Gibson, Attorney Estergren was not present due to illness, Councilmen Lowell Taylor, Iva Booher, Paul Hutchison, and Peter Sonnenberg.

Minutes of the last meeting was read. Councilman Sonnenberg moved we accept the minutes as read, seconded by Councilman Taylor. Motion carried.

Councilman Sonnenberg moved we accept the finance report as read, seconded by Councilman Hutchison. Motion carried.

Mr. Whitehead and Mr. Crayle from Crayle and Co., were present at the meeting to present a sealed bid for paving. Coastal Asphalt forwarded a sealed bid to our past office box. Councilman Sonnenberg moved we accept the bid from Crayle and Co. at \$2,667 to pave with curb and guttering one block on Garnett Street from Andalusia to Eglin Parkway, one block on Laverne Street from Irwin Street to Yacht Club Drive. Work to begin within 30 days and to be completed within a three week time elimate, seconded by Councilman Hutchison. Motion carried.

Councilman Booher moved we accept the proposal with the Humane Society requiring persons requesting service to pay one half of the five dollars fee charged, billing the city the remaining one half, seconded by Councilman Hutchison. Motion carried.

Councilman Tyalor moved we repair the driveway on city property at the W. A. Cartwright rental property not to exceed \$12 for clay and trucking, seconded by Councilman Hutchison. Motion carried.

Councilman Taylor moved we renew our membership with the League of Municipalities at \$55 for dues per year, seconded by Councilman Hutchison. Motion carried.

Councilman Taylor moved we amend existing motion maintaining parks to include the cleaning of streets and right ways when needed year around basis as necessary, seconded by Councilamn Sonnenberg. Motion carried.

Councilman Hutchison moved we make all future deposits in certificates at the First Peoples Bank and continue using our checking account at First National Bank and leave certificates already on deposit, seconded by Councilman Sonnenberg. Motion carried.

Being no further business, Councilman Hutchison moved we adjourn the meeting, seconded by Councilman Sonnenberg. Motion carried.
