

Town of Cinco Bayou Council Meeting  
August 10, 1959 7:30 p.m.

Present: Gordon Gibson, L.P. Disharoom, Paul Hutchinson, Millard Booher, Billy Gibson, Fred Estergren, and James Rice.

Meeting was called to order by the Mayor and the minutes were read and approved.

Discussion was held concerning the length of time cars should be parked on city praks and the permanent docking of boats at the city dock. The Council decided to put up signs simply stating there would be no permanent docking of boats and no parking for purposes other than using the park.

Discussion was held concerning the fence that Mr. Phillips has erected between his property and that of Laguna Park in Cinco. Before any legal action will be taken, Mr. Estergren will talk to his lawyer to see if he will remove the fence at the 340' mark without any trouble.

The town ordinances are in order as far as the material on hand is concerned. They can't be numbered until some old originals can be located.

Mr. Estergren read a resolution stating that the County Commissioners of Okaloosa County would be responsible for the disposal and burial of garbage for Cinco Bayou at the rate of \$.50 per family until per month or a given amount upon the agreement of the Council. Mr. Disharoom moved we accept the resolution at \$75 per month. B. Gibson seconded the motion and the vote was unanimous.

Mr. Disharoom move we pay a \$25 donation to the Ski Club for prizes in a forthcoming ski meet. Mr. Booher seconded the motion and vote was unanimous. It was agreed the Elk's Club could sell fried fish and soft drinks at same if they clean up park.

Mr. Booher moved we donate \$100 to the Lifeguard Fund for Wayside Park. B. Gibson seconded the motion and the vote was unanimous.

B. Gibson moved the attorney fee be raised to \$25 per month. Mr. Disharoom seconded the motion and the vote was unanimous.

Mr. Booher moved we accept an ordinance "prohibiting the parking and or storing of any trailer, etc. used for sleeping or living purposes on any piece of land not licensed for such". B. Gibson seconded the motion. Vote unanimous.

Mr. Booher moved the meeting be adjourned. L. Disharoom seconded. Unanimous.
