

**TOWN OF CINCO BAYOU
VISION WORKSHOP MEETING MINUTES
16 August 2001**

Chairman/Councilman Dan Farley called the Vision Workshop Meeting to order at 6:03 P.M. Present at the meeting were: Councilman Dan Farley, Mayor Randall Drabczuk, Councilman Sara Carroll, Councilman Carol Koch, Town Manager/Clerk Nell Webb, Assistant Monika Gillette, and residents Ron and Rai DeGranges.

After Chairman Farley opened the meeting it was decided that no meeting would be held August 23, 2001 and that the next meeting would be August 30, 2001. He updated the group on the technical grant request stating that he had not heard back yet about the status. After discussing looking at broad areas to define such as zoning, finance, management and ordinances, it was decided that the meeting on the 30th would be a walking tour. The meeting would begin at Town Hall and from there the participants would walk the town to get a better perspective on what needed to be done.


