PUBLIC HEARING

1. Ordinance No. 162 - An ordinance of the Town of Cinco Bayou, Florida amending Chapter 17, SIGNS, Cinco Bayou Code of Ordinances. Although adoption of this ordinance was allowed as an emergency action, it was decided that the regular ordinance adoption procedures would be followed and the ordinance would be presented for the first reading. Attorney McInnis read Ordinance No. 162 by title only. Councilman Gage made a motion to approve the first reading of Ordinance No 162, seconded by Councilwoman Chamberlain. Attorney McInnis recommended that the title include the severability clause, repealing clause and effective date declaration. Councilwoman Chamberlain made a motion to amend the ordinance title accordingly, seconded by Councilman Gage. The motion was unanimously approved. The initial motion was also unanimously approved.

Mayor Laginess announced that this ordinance would be on the September 6, 1994 agenda for second reading and council action.

ORDINANCE NO. 162

AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWN OF CINCO BAYOU, FLORIDA AMENDING CHAPTER 17, SIGNS, CINCO BAYOU CODE OF ORDINANCES.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF CINCO BAYOU, FLORIDA THAT:

SECTION 1. Section 17-6, **Exempt signs.** Paragraph (3) is hereby repealed.

Section 2. Severability

If any word, sentence, phrase, clause, section or portion of this ordinance shall be held invalid or unconstitutional by a court of competent jurisdiction, such portion of words shall be deemed a separate and independent provision and such holding shall not effect the validity of the remaining portion thereof.

Section 3. Repeal of Conflicting Ordinances and Resolutions.

All ordinances and resolutions of the governing body in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

Section 4. Effective Date.

This ordinance shall become effective immediately upon its adoption.
