

Town of Cinco Bayou Council Meeting
September 2, 1969

Cinco Bayou Council Meeting 7:30 p.m. Present Mayor Edward Laritz, Attorney Estergren, Councilmen Lowell Taylor, Iva Booher, and Paul Hutchison.

Councilman Taylor moved the minutes be accepted as read. Seconded by Councilman Booher. Motion carried.

Councilman Booher moved to accept the monthly finance report as read. Seconded by Councilman Taylor. Carried unanimously.

Attorney Estergren read the amendment to the 1954 ordinance requiring 20 gallons metal containers be used for garbage cans. Councilman Taylor moved to accept the amendment to the ordinance as read. Seconded by Councilman Booher. Motion carried. Councilman Taylor moved to accept amending existing ordinance C1 and C2 Commercial districts as written. Seconded by Councilman Hutchison. Motion carried.

Attorney Estergren announced election of officers to be held October 7, 1969. All petitions to be filed by 12' midnight September 21, 1969. Councilman Hutchison moved to appoint Mrs. Marjorie Crawford to sit at the Town Hall during registration beginning September 4 - 27. Seconded by Councilman Taylor. Motion carried.

Councilman Taylor moved a letter be written to the Moose Lodge informing them the building owned by Vista Lumber Company, Blk 18, Lots 6 and 7 could be used to operate their club. Provided there be ample parking space with off street parking and alcoholic beverages be served to members only. Seconded by Councilman Hutchison. Carried unanimously.

Mayor Laritz appointed Harold Peek to serve remaining term of Councilman Peter Sonnennberg until Oct 1, 1970 due to his resignation.

Councilman Booher moved Harold Peek be appointed to serve the remainder

of term of Councilman Sonnenberg. Seconded by Councilman Taylor. Motion carried unanimously.

Councilman Booher moved to allow the Kiwanis Club to maintain the Leyenda Park. Seconded by Councilman Hutchison. Motion carried unanimously.

Being no further business Councilman Booher moved we adjourn. Seconded by Councilman Taylor. Motion carried unanimously.
