


TOWN OF CINCO BAYOU
SPECIAL CALLED MEETING
3 SEPTEMBER 2003

Mayor Norm Frucci called the Special Called Meeting to order at 6:00 P.M. Present at the meeting were: Mayor Norm Frucci, Councilman Carol Koch, Councilman Dutch Payne, Councilman Jim Bratton, Councilman Rod DesGranges, Attorney Jeff McInnis, Town Manager/Clerk Nell Webb and Assistant Monika Gillette.

Attorney McInnis read by title Ordinance 200: AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 82 OF THE CODE OF ORDINANCES OF THE TOWN OF CINCO BAYOU, FLORIDA, BY RETAINING EXPRESS PROHIBITION ON THE ERECTION OF BILLBOARDS, ALSO KNOWN AS OFF-SITE SIGNS; REAFFIRMING ABILITY TO PLACE NONCOMMERCIAL SPEECH WHERE COMMERCIAL SPEECH IS PERMITTED; PROVIDING PROCEDURES FOR AN APPEALS PROCESS; PROVIDING PROCEDURES FOR DENIAL OF A PERMIT; DELETING OBSOLETE LANGUAGE; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

Attorney McInnis explained it was a revision of the current sign ordinance revising obsolete language and adding additional support and clarification. Mayor Frucci asked for discussion and began review of the ordinance. Councilman DesGranges questioned some duplication in the "where as" portion of the ordinance and a reference to the Federal Highway system. Attorney McInnis stated he would check for duplication and the research if the reference to the Federal Highway System was accurate. Also discussed was a time table for removing political signs as well as clarifying specifications on reader boards. Councilman Payne motioned to accept the first reading of Ordinance 201. Councilman Koch seconded the motion. The motion passed unanimously. Councilman DesGranges excused himself from the meeting before the vote on the motion was made.

Adjourn – There being no further business, the meeting adjourned at 7:00 pm
