

Town of Cinco Bayou Council Meeting  
September 5, 1967

Cinco Bayou Council Meeting, 7:30 p.m. Present Mayor Ronald Gibson, Attorney Estergren, Councilmen Harold Peek, Lowell Taylor, Paul Hutchison, Edward Laritz, and Peter Sonnenberg.

Minutes of the previous meeting were read. Councilman Laritz moved the minutes be accepted as read, seconded by Councilman Taylor. Motion carried.

Attorney Estergren reported a letter had been mailed to the State Comptroller's Office to obtain a tax exemption number for the city.

Councilman Laritz and Mayor Gibson volunteered to inspect the town's need for extra street lights.

Councilman Laritz moved we accept the bid made by Crayle & Co., at \$5,610 to pave Opp Blvd and Kelly Avenue opposed to the bid made by Okaloosa Asphalt Co. bid at \$6,439.25, seconded by Councilman Taylor. Mr. Crayle announced work would begin on the paving within two weeks. He ask the Council to appoint someone to inspect the paving periodically. Mayor Gibson appointed Councilman Laritz and Councilman to inspect the street paving.

Being no further business, meeting adjourned.
